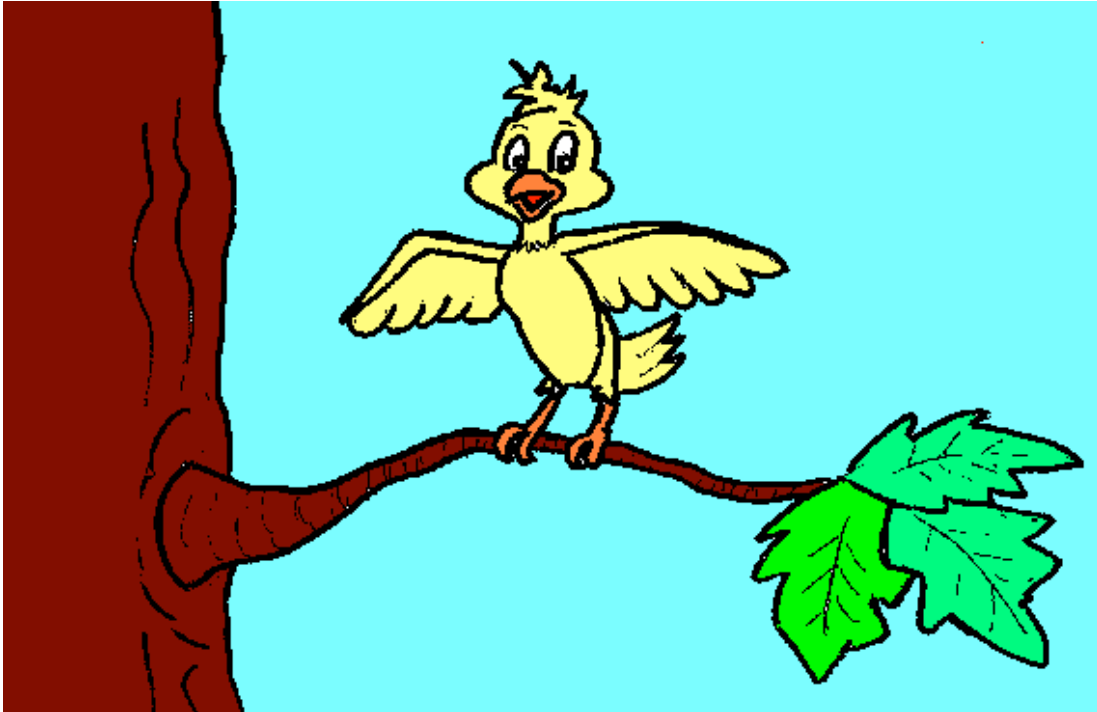


I'm learning to fly!

PLEASE DON'T PICK ME UP!



BABY BIRDS LEARN TO FLY BY PRACTICING ON THE GROUND. PARENT BIRDS WILL FEED AND CARE FOR THEM.

Do not "rescue" fledglings - Please keep your dogs and cats inside and leave baby birds that are learning to fly in the wild where they belong.

Baby birds must be fed every hour for two months.
Mother & Father birds have more time for this than we do!

If you find an **INJURED** animal, please **CALL 917-BIRD** or the National Trust. **Always** write down the **EXACT** location where the animal was found and your name and phone number so we can release the animal near its home territory.
